How to Make a Paper Plate Owl

Materials:

Paper plate Glue Ribbon





Tape Scissors Construction paper Paint/markers/crayons

- 1. Fold sides of plate in to center. These will be the wings.
- 2. Fold over the top of plate. This will be the head.
- 3. Decorate the plate—use markers, paint or crayons. Look at the photos of Albany Pine Bush owls for inspiration.
- 4. Glue the wings and head down.
- 5. Finish decorating. You can paint feathers on the body if you want.
- 6. Cut out eyes, beak and feet from construction paper.
- 7. Glue the eyes, beak and feet to the owl's body.
- 8. Tape the ribbon to the back of your owl.
