

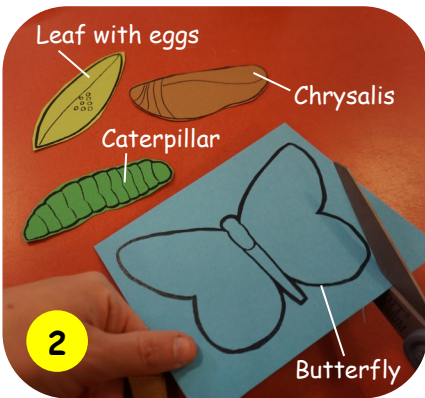
Karner Blue Butterfly Life Cycle Mobile!

Materials needed

- Paper plate
- Butterfly life cycle shapes printout (leaf with eggs, caterpillar, chrysalis, butterfly)
- Writing utensil (optional)
- Crayons/colored pencils/markers (optional)
- Scissors
- Tape
- String

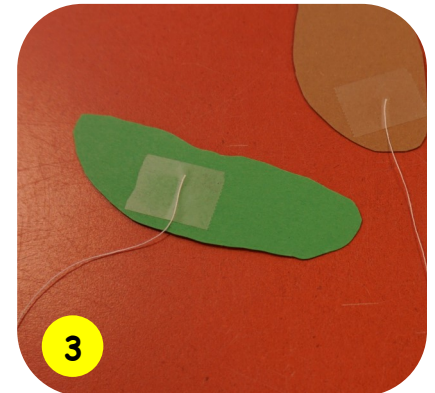


Step 1: Cut your paper plate in a spiral. It can be helpful to draw your spiral first, and then cut along the line you drew.



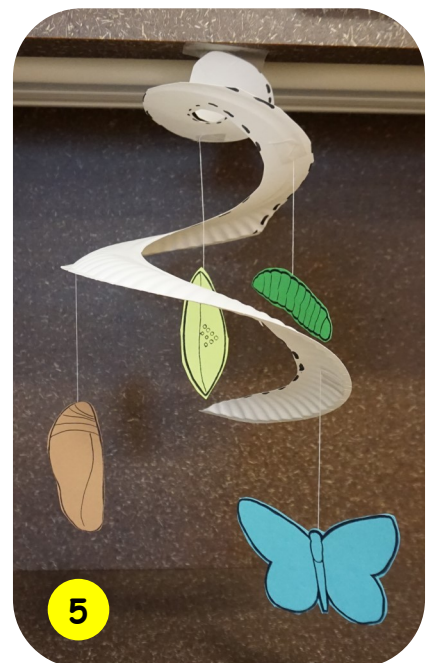
Step 2: Print out your butterfly life cycle shapes and color in if desired. Cut out each shape.

Step 3: Tape a short piece of string, about four inches, to the back of each of your shapes.



Step 4: Tape the other ends of your strings along the edge of the spiral, spacing the shapes out evenly.

Starting near the center, attach in this order: leaf, caterpillar, chrysalis, butterfly.



Step 5: Tape or tie your mobile somewhere it can hang down and spin freely. Enjoy your new piece of science-inspired art!
